Tuition may be paid by cash, check, or Venmo and is due at the first lesson of each month. *This is a monthly fee, not a per-lesson fee.* Tuition reserves the weekly slot and covers a variety of other studio expenses including recitals.

Make-up lessons: Most piano studios do not offer this service, but because of the performances I give as an

accompanist, I try to keep a flexible policy. If I am the one requesting the make-up, I will give advance notice and find you another spot. Likewise, if you give me advance notice, I will find a make-up spot for you. I also keep the last week of each semester open for make-ups. However, sometimes, as in the case of illness, a lesson must simply be excused, and students should keep practicing. *Never stop practicing!*
